

Cookie Policy

When you access the website of NAT Absolute Technologies Public Company Limited (referred to as "the Company") (<https://www.natat.co.th>), your information when visit will be stored in the form of cookies. This cookie policy explains the meaning, functioning, purposes, as well as how to delete and reject cookies for your privacy. By accessing this website, you consent to us using cookies in accordance with the detailed cookie policy below.

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files downloaded to your computer or mobile device, which store information and settings for the use of websites and/or applications, such as language preferences, your current service login status, and information about your preferred browsing history. This helps you access the Company's website and/or application continuously without any disruptions. Cookies do not pose any danger to your computer or mobile device, and the contents of cookies can only be accessed or read by the services that create those cookies.

2. Benefits of Cookies

Cookies inform the Company about the sections of the website and/or application you use, enabling the Company to provide you with an improved and personalized user experience tailored to your preferences. Additionally, saving initial service settings with cookies allows you to access the service with preset values each time, except when cookies are deleted, which resets all settings to default.

3. Types of Cookies Used

3.1 Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the Company's services, allowing you to use various functions on the website and/or application securely, such as login management cookies and your login status.

3.2 Performance-Enhancing Cookies

3.2.1 Analytical and Performance Cookies

These cookies enhance the performance of the services, facilitating your use of the services and assisting the Company in understanding your preferences better. Examples of improved services using this type of cookie include visitor analytics and behavioral tracking on the Company's website and/or application. The Company uses this information to improve and enhance the efficiency of the services to align with your interests.

Examples of enhancing your experience with this type of cookie include Google Analytics.

3.2.2 Advertising Cookies

These cookies are stored on your computer or mobile device to collect information about your usage and the links you follow or visit. This helps the Company understand your preferences and allows the Company and/or third parties to present information, promotions, and advertisements that are most relevant to your interests.

Examples of enhancing your experience with this type of cookie include Google Analytics, Social Media Analytics, and Truehits.

However, in cases where the Company uses this type of cookie to collect, use, or disclose your personal information for advertising purposes, the Company will seek your consent or comply with the applicable data protection laws.

4. Cookie Settings and Deactivation

You have the option to enable or disable all types of cookies based on your preferences.

If you choose to disable cookies by adjusting your browser settings and set your privacy preferences to stop collecting data through cookies in the future (additional details can be found at AboutCookies.org), you can continue to access the Company's website and/or application.

However, disabling cookies may affect some or all functions of the Company's services, making them less smooth or unavailable.

5. Data Linking to Other Websites

The Company's website may contain links to external websites or social media platforms. These external websites or social media platforms may embed content or videos, such as YouTube or Facebook, allowing you to access content and interact with others on social media from the Company's website. 6. Changes to the Policy


